TIMELINE broke forwardly placed, drew up to MEANTIME and pressed that opponent for a furlong beginning from the seven and half marker, was allowed to drop back as the tempo picked up a couple of ticks during the setting of the second fraction, was patiently ridden drafting off the right soulder of the leader, racing three to four wide on the turn, picked up interest coming to the quarter pole, closed the gap stepping into the stretch, somewhat aided by MEANTIME having sputtered four to five into the stretch, cut over to the rail as a duel with that foe commenced right around the three-sixteenths pole, vied side by side before kicking clear in the final sixteenth. MEANTIME responded to some light hand urging after springing from the gate to establish control, felt some pressure from the winner early, shook free by picking up the pace after the setting of the opening split to show the way loosely attended thereafter, departed the backstretch towards the three path, drifted four to five wide into the lane, momentarily losing momentum just at the winner was mustering up some of his own, angled sharply into the two path once straightened away to give a better view of the nemesis, tussled with the top one from the three-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole but failed to re-claim the front, ultimately having to settle for being second best. IMPRESSIVE EDGE got spotted in midpack after the start, pursued the leader from the four path on the turn, got set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, made no headway in the final furlong. TAKE YOUR GUNS stumbled badly at the break, raced from off the inside throughout, sat parked out five wide on the turn, wandered out into path seven from upper to midstretch, made no impact. MASTER PLAN lost his footing at the start, took up the chase from the two path, was under a brisk hand ride by the half mile pole, gave way. LOOKIN AT BLESSING sent over to the rail at the top of the turn, was never in contention.
