Bred by Dell Ridge Farm, PARTISAN POLITICS broke out a step at the start, settled just off the pace in the two path, got bumped solidly seven and a half furlongs out as ANCIENT GODDESS grew eager along the inside and came out to avoid running up the heels of SUNDAY SONNET and in turn bumped MAGNIFICENT MARGO four to five wide into the first turn and RAINHA DA BATERIA five to six wide into the first turn, settled two to three wide mid pack behind the cover of SLAVA, angled four wide three furlongs out placed to coaxing, spun three wide for home into contention, rallied to collar the front a just outside the eighth pole, edged away under a drive before prevailing under a vigorous hand ride to the wire through the late stages. SUNDAY SONNET cut the pace in hand along the inside, cut the corner set down into upper stretch under challenge, got headed steps outside the eighth pole, dug in along the inside and kept on, came under a near sided whip in the late stages coming out to look ANCIENT GODDESS in the eye to preserve the place honors. ANCIENT GODDESS (FR) rank early on into the first turn keen to go on despite the rider's restraint, came out a path seven and a half furlongs out bumping PARTISAN POLITICS into MAGINIFICENT MARGO and in turn RAINHA DA BATERIA pushing those foes three, five and six wide accordingly into the first turn, settled just off the inside in close aim behind the cover of SLAVA, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, rallied with mild late foot for the show honors shying out slightly late as SUNDAY SONNET came over in the last jumps. RAINHA DA BATERIA a bit fractious in the gate, got floated five to six wide seven and a half furlongs out due to the rankness of ANCIENT GODDESS causing a chain reaction of bumping, tucked to the two path seven furlongs out before shifting to the three path down the backside, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, offered up a late mild bid for the last major share. MAGNIFICENT MARGO floated five wide seven and a half furlongs out due to ANCIENT GODDESS growing eager along the inside and coming out a path to escape the heels of SUNDAY SONNET, tucked quickly to the fence seven furlongs from home before angling just off the inside into the backside, remained patiently handled to the five-sixteenths, came under urging at that station, spun four wide into upper stretch, made no headway. FLYING TIPAT tracked the pace along the inside in range behind the cover of SUNDAY SONNET, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, bumped lightly with SLAVA at that station as that one retreated, angled three wide into upper stretch behind the eventual winner and weakened in the drive SLAVA two to three wide in closest range of the leader, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, got bumped lightly by FLYING TIPAT at
