By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$12,500 by the time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees.) \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start with \$150,000 guaranteed. This race includes an additional \$100,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Nominees only. Keeneland Association money to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup F and money also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded reverts back to the Fund. Weight: Three-year-olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 20 08 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2008, 4 lbs; a Grade III or \$60,000 twice in 2008, 6 lbs. A gold julep cup and a Breeders' Cup Trophy to be presented to the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 24, 2008 with 30 nominations. (Clear 74)

SING BABY SING behind the leaders off the inside, moved out three wide midway through the turn, responded to pressure in the stretch and rallied willingly to be up in time. TALENT SEARCH vied for the lead near the rail through fast fractions, drew clear in midstretch but faltered late. CARNACKS CHOICE outrun early, commenced his rally in the three path on the turn and closed well late. DISFUNCTION forwardly placed from the start, moved out four wide midway through the turn for a clear path but lodged only a mild late bid. LEGAL MOVE within striking distance, split rivals three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. NOONMARK reserved off the inside, was no threat. SEMAPHORE MAN forced the pace outside TALENT SEARCH, pressured that one to the stretch, held on well to near the final furlong and tired. EMIRATES TO DUBAI sluggish at the start, was outrun to the stretch and rallied belatedly. NAKAYAMA ARASHI bumped after the start, raced within striking distance early, moved out to the five path midway through the turn and tired. PICTURAL bumped after the start, could not menace.
