6 FURLONGS. (1.10⁴) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 (Includes \$100,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) PHOENIX BREEDERS' CUP S.(GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 by the time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees,) \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150 ,000 added, and an additional \$100,000 from Breeders' Cup for Cup eligibles only. Keeneland Association added monies and all fees to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weight: Three-year-olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; Grade III or \$60,000 twice in 2006, 4 lbs; \$45,000 twice in 2006, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup and a Breeders' Cup trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 27, 2006 with 24 nominations. (Clear 61)

Dark Bay or Brown Gelding, (Apr), by Patton - Best Game by Great Above. Trainer Kenneally Eddie. Bred by Summerplace Farm(KY).

KELLY'S LANDING, outsprinted early, raced between foes around the turn and into the stretch, was alertly angled to the rail at the furlong grounds and was hard ridden to prevail. AREYOUTALKINTOME, never far back, raced four or five wide, made a bold bid to battle with the winner on even terms while outside that one leaving the sixteenth pole but wasn't good enough at the end. LEVEL PLAYINGFIELD, outrun for a half and three or four wide, swung out seven or eight wide for the stretch run and finished willingly. COACH JIMI LEE angled in early to stalk the pace four wide, moved wider for the drive, loomed prominently for the last eighth and came up empty. SILVER WAGON, bumped at the start, quickly gained a striking position between horses three or four wide, lost position on the turn and fell back last, came out nine wide entering the stretch and lacked a serious response. SPANISH CHESTNUT sprinted to the fore early, raced two or three wide, was clear for the drive and gave way readily. JUDITHS WILD RUSH, bumped at the start by VICARAGE and forced out on SILVER WAGON, raced within striking distance two or three wide to the stretch, weakened and was steadied behind VICARAGE nearing the final furlong. VICARAGE drifted out at the start bumping JUDITHS WILD RUSH, went up soon after to chase front-running SPANISH CHESTNUT while inside that one, eased outside of SPANISH CHESTNUT on the turn, continued forwardly to the stretch and faltered. ELUSIVE JAZZ, outrun inside to the stretch, angled four wide, maneuvered wider in the late going but never fired.
