TENFOLD settled off the pace while inside, eased out advancing heading towards the lane, split rivals leaving mid stretch, kicked clear inside the sixteenth pole then was all out to fend off YOU'RE TO BLAME. YOU'RE TO BLAME, brushed then squeezed at the break, lost ground four wide under coaxing, swung six wide for the drive and closed gamely to just miss. CORDMAKER, forward early, dropped back between rivals leaving the far turn, angled seven wide into the lane and rallied. WAIT FOR IT prompted the pace three deep, dueled on near even terms into the lane, took over in upper stretch, briefly went clear inside the three sixteenths, was hooked from his inside past the eighth pole and faded late. JUST WHISTLE was shuffled back under the wire the first time, settled towards the rail, angled out approaching the lane, worked his way between foes and churned on. CARLINO bobbled at the break, lagged far back while saving ground, swung well wide with momentum past mid stretch, straightened and closed the gap. CLUBMAN, three wide between foes early, took closer order after six furlongs, swung out in upper stretch, ranged up nearing the eighth pole then faded. UNBRIDLED JUAN lost ground four wide while in range, was making some headway past the three sixteenths, steadied and came up empty. RALLY CRY, in mid pack and to the inside of rivals, angled four wide in upper stretch, moved up some then had to check when in close near the furlong grounds. HEAVY ROLLER had speed between rivals then rated back and angled in, stalked to the five sixteenths then gave way. FLYING THE FLAG moved up to the inside and gained a short lead after a guarter mile, set moderate fractions, dueled to the inside of a pair of foes past the five sixteenths to upper stretch then succumbed. BOBBY G failed to menace. FLAMEAWAY prompted the pace two wide into the backstretch, dueled between foes past the five sixteenths, gained a brief lead then faltered
