PAGE MCKENNEY, taken to rate while saving ground early, came off the inside and pulled his way forward between rivals into the far turn, was patiently handled stalking the leaders leaving the five sixteenths, was briefly stalled behind foes in upper stretch, altered out for clear sailing nearing the eighth pole, straightened away and gave valiant chase to the wire. CAT BURGLAR, four wide stalking the pace, edged up to threaten leaving the far turn, forced the issue under a ride approaching the quarter pole, could not go on with the winner leaving the three sixteenths but kept on willingly to the wire. TOP BILLING broke a step slow then was angled in, lagged off the pace while two wide past the five eighth pole, came under pressure into the far turn, gained ground nearing the lane, swung out five to six wide for the drive and continued with interest though not a threat to the top pair. ENCRYPTION cleared into the first turn while two wide, was joined by the winner into the backstretch, vied inside that one into the far turn, came under a ride continuing the battle past the five sixteenths, stayed willingly to mid stretch then faded. TRANSPARENT rated off the leaders while saving ground, was put to a solid hand ride chasing past the three eighths pole, shifted out leaving the three sixteenths and came up empty. VYJACK was lightly steadied off heels into the first turn, angled well out into the track, edged up five wide into the far turn, gave hard pursuit leaving the three eighths pole, failed to continue on past the five sixteenths, faltered
