1 1/4 MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 *PLEASANT COLONY S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2010.* No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. \$1,000 to enter. Starters to receive a \$750 rebate. All supplemental nominess will be required to pay entry fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs., such a race since then, 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, August 21, 2010 with 17 Nominations. (Clear 75)

TRICKMEISTER quickly took command, under his power, showed the way from the three path around the opening bend, with all but one rival being placed farther from the inside, continued along the uncontested front end down the backstretch, with the rider keeping plenty in reserve, sat chilly on the lead, now positioned towards the two path by this time, approaching the head of the stretch, safely fending off a now heavily roused OUR DARK KNIGHT, displayed a sudden burst of speed when asked for run straightening away into the lane, drew off to a commanding advantage during the ensuing furlong, had the rider take one quick peek back at the distant competition before cruising the final furlong under the mildest of hand rides. OUR DARK KNIGHT chased the top one while undertaking a wide journey, was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, but made no headway, continued on well during the stretch drive to secure the place. REGAL WARRIOR outrun for nearly three-quarters, swung four wide into the stretch and was along for the show. MODERN COWBOY four wide around the first turn, folded. WESTSHORE strung out four wide on the opening bend, was guided over to the inside by midpoint on the backstretch, took the inside route thereafter and tired.
