**1 MILE, (1.33<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 POCAHONTAS S.(GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD.** By subscription of \$150 each on or before October 10, 2007 or by supplementary nomination of \$7,500 each at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Pocahontas will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 10, 2007 with 48 nominations. (Clear 61)

Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Pure Prize - Gather The Clan (IRE) by General Assembly. Trainer Holthus E. Robert. Bred by A. Lakin & Sons, Inc.(KY).

PURE CLAN bobbed at the start and was squeezed back by CAPE DISCOVERY when that one came in, settled in hand five wide, circled horses ten wide entering the stretch, caught front-running AUTHENTICAT leaving the sixteenth pole and drove clear. AUTHENTICAT, never far back, advanced five or six wide around the turn and into the lane, took over, edged clear, then was not a match for PURE CLAN at the end.

SKY MOM, never far back and between foes three or four wide, had to briefly await room about mid-stretch, eased out six wide soon after and finished willingly. SIX PACK SAMMY, within striking distance always and near the inside, had aim in the drive but came up empty. MIMS EPPI, outrun until the stretch, moved from between horses five wide to make a mild run leaving the furlong grounds but lacked a final account.

ANACHINI worked her way in early to follow the leaders five or six wide, made a menacing run to reach the front a quarter-mile out but gradually weakened when straightened for the drive. KADIRA vied for the lead from the beginning while between rivals three wide, raced heads apart to the head of the stretch and weakened. TEQUILAS DAYJUR, well placed between horses four wide to the stretch, flattened out when the test came. BAMBOO, outrun to the stretch, was steadied at the quarter-mile ground, worked her way out ten wide for the last eighth and never menaced. BEE'S WAX wasn't a factor. BOUND TO failed to reach contention. VALENTINE FEVER tired on the turn. CAPE DISCOVERY bobbed badly at the start and drifted in bothering the winner, went up to force the pace three abreast, raced forwardly for six furlongs, gave way readily and was not abused in the late going when hopelessly beaten. STEAMY RIDGE battled for the lead along the inside for five furlongs, gave way and was eased late.
