DANCINGINHERDREAMS pulled to contention between horses, waited in traffic through the turn, weaved between rivals entering the stretch, shifted to the inside and quickened when put to pressure, shook clear was taken in hand the final sixteenth and widened. EDEN STAR settled in hand, circled four wide to make her bid, was unable to match strides with the winner but dug in and held the place.

MISSYOULIKECRAZY was allowed to settle, came four wide but lacked the needed late response. GRAN LIONESS stalked the pace three wide, forged a clear lead leaving the turn, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. DAYS LIKE THIS was forwardly placed toward the inside to the turn and faded. SWITCHING GEARS was unhurried into stride six wide and failed to respond. HONEY CHILE was away alertly, angled in to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed.
