SIGN fought restraint the opening half when within striking distance, worked her way forward between rivals on the turn, angled in approaching the furlong marker for a clear path, made a bold move to the lead and drew off late under steady urging. GAL ABOUT TOWN vied for the lead three wide, dropped back a bit before a half, came again to take over for the drive but was no match for the winner late. CLOUDY VOW forwardly placed four wide, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. CLOUDY IN SANDIEGO reserved for a half, raced in the three path on the turn and improved position, no threat. SEASONED WARRIOR outrun early, made a good four wide move on the turn, reached a forward position with a furlong to go but could not sustain the bid. DANALAKE close up from the start, raced off the inside around the bend and tired in the drive. BROTHERHOOD SINGER within reach while off the inside, gave way. LA SONG alternated for the lead off the rail, held on to the stretch and faded.
