REALLY MR GREELY had speed between foes then angled in and set the pace inside, responded when rivals loomed on the turn, inched away again under left handed urging in the stretch and held gamely. SUPER NINETY NINE three deep early, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished willingly between foes on the line. SHAKIN IT UP saved ground chasing the pace, came out for room in upper stretch, was briefly in a bit close off heels in midstretch, came out again and continued on well three wide on the wire. Z BIG APPLE between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. HEIR KITTY pulled her way up inside to stalk the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid between horses on the turn, dropped back toward the inside past midstretch and weakened.
