6 FURLONGS. (1.073) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 (Includes \$50,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) *PRIORESS S.(GRADE I)* FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Cup nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded revert back to the Fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000; or \$45,000 in 2008, 4 lbs.; \$30,000, or two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, restricted and restricted stake races s not considered in allowances). A trophies to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. INDIAN BLESSING reserved while widest on the turn, ranged up to the leaders to reach even terms heading for the stretch, responded when roused in upper stretch to take charge, left the furlong marker with a comfortable advantage, had the rider give a quick glance back at the sixteenth pole, before being vigorously hand ridden the remainder of the way. BY THE LIGHT vied for the lead along the inside, failed to keep pace with the top one during the stretch drive, but continued on with good courage to be second best. INDIAN WAY outrun along the rail, was swung wide at the top of the lane, and was up late for the show. SECRET GYPSY set a pressured pace for a half and gave way. TALE OF THE WEST raced three wide and steadily tired after going three furlongs.
