CAVORTING broke a length the fastest, was allowed to drop back into a stalking role, sat perched in the three path keeping watch on a

four-ply pace dispute, picked up interest when asked as the half was being completed, swung out towards the six path before getting

straightened away, sped to the front to take control by the furlong marker, steadily extended the margin, crossing the wire put to a strong hand

drive. BAR OF GOLD was unhurried in the two path for almost a half, got maneunvered oiut into the seven path during the initial portion of the

stretch run, failed to keep pace with the top one in the final furlong, yet came home willingly herself procuring the place. FUSAICHI RED bumped from both sides right after springing from the gate, cut over to the rail nearing the conclusion of the backstretch, stayed put travelling on the turn, was put to encouragement spinning outward until five wide, displayed a good kick to secure the show. PAID UP SUBSCRIBER bumped solidly with IRISH JASPER at the break, took up the chase from the three path on the turn, shifted towards the middle of the strip after stepping onto the stretch until about six wide deep into the furlong grounds, finished well to earn the last major check. TRICKY ZIPPY was excused from the post

parade, leaving it immediately after entering the track, broke to the inside in an awkward manner, eventually maknig conttact with the nearest opponent, that being FUSAICHI RED, attained a promient position, contended for the lead three wide and from between rivals until upper stretch before giving way. IRISH JASPER bumped with some force into PAID UP SUBSCRIBER as the field was sent off and running, departed the backstretch from the two path, was angled out to the eighth one, becoming the widest of all, mustered up a mild response thereafter.

CLOTHES FALL OFF was bumped from each end shortly after the start, quickly tucked along the inside route, was coaxed keeping an eye on a heavily-contested pace, arrived at the quarter pole with usable clearance along the hedge to launch her rally and did so, was forced to check when put in tight deep into the furlong grounds, resulting in both a loss of momentum and ground, angled outward in an attempt to get back into it only to have the pilot lost the whip near the sixteenth pole, was hand urged completing a luckless trip. SKY GOLD bumped at the break, got bumped a second time after going onward for a few more jumps, was in the two path, wedged in the middle of rivals, vyiing for commnad until upper stretch then gave way. EKATI'S PHAETON made contact with SKY GOLD at the break, responded to some light hand urging and took the advantage soon afterwards, showed the way from the rail, hounded by a threesome parked out in paths two through four, drifted slightly entering

the lane thus becoming two wide, caved in to the assault with a furlong to go and backed away. PROMISE ME SILVER a pace factor in the four path, pressed the issue as the widest of a guartet for a half and tired.
