LEXIE LOU settled in midpack, closed into the far turn, came in and bumped ASSERTING BEAR upper stretch, took command then held under a drive. AMI'S HOLIDAY, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn, encountered traffic at the top of the stretch, cut to the rail a furlong out and finished gamely. ASSERTING BEAR, prominent early, took the lead entering the backstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the far turn, dueled, wore down his rival and led into the stretch, bumped with LEXIE LOU, yielded the lead then chased to the end. WE MISS ARTIE reared at the start, settled off the pace, closed fast five-wide on the far turn, was up close in the stretch but flattened out. NIIGON EXPRESS, away slowly, settled off the pace, chased hard four-wide on the far turn then finished all out. LIONS BAY raced in midpack, closed three-wide into the far turn, moved to the rail and chased hard then evened out in the stretch. MATADOR raced in midpack, closed three-wide into the far turn, was hustled along, chased four-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. HEART TO HEART, in range early along the rail, stalked on the backstretch, chased three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. COLTIMUS PRIME held a short early lead, was headed entering the backstretch, bid into the far turn, vied, gave way late turn and tired. ATHENIAN GUARD settled off the pace, closed along the rail on the backstretch, chased on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. CAP IN HAND stalked the pace, was hustled into the far turn, tired midturn and faded. ONE DESTINY settled in midpack, saved ground, was hustled on the far turn but lacked a closing response. MAN O' BEAR, in range to the far turn, faded between foes. TOWER OF TEXAS raced in midpack, dropped back nearing the far turn and lacked a rally. MAJESTIC SUNSET, prominent early, dropped back on the backstretch, continued to fade on the turn and was eased in the stretch. MAJESTIC SUNSET finished the race and walked off.
