5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1:01) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Quick Call S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123. Non-winners of \$90,000 in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2015 allowed 4 lbs., of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2015 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2015 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, July 25, 2015 with 29 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.) (Rail at 18 feet). (Cloudy 73)

READY FOR RYE three to four wide in pursuit of the front from just off the pace, came under urging and swung four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied into contention a furlong from home, seized command inside the sixteenth marker and edged away to the wire. THE GREAT WAR broke out at the start and was corrected, chased the pace three then two wide forwardly placed in close aim of the leader, came under urging past the five-sixteenths, swung just off the inside for home, issued a challenge between foes to seize command a furlong out among a quintet stacked across the track at that station, dug in and was headed inside the sixteenth marker and ran on to just hold for the place honors. DISCO PARTNER bumped at the start lightly by BEANTOWN SAINT, chased the pace along the inside near the rear, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish surging late and just missed for the place honors. CYCLOGENISIS just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside for home in behind foes, was under a tepid ride awaiting a seam and unable to alter out in traffic, got clearance inside the sixteenth marker and came on through late to improve position for the last major share given only a handful of jumps to do so. SLEEPING GIANT hustled from the start vied three wide early between foes among four hunting for the front before the field spread a bit, came vied three wide through the turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, dug in under a drive in prominence and was leaned on by GALLERY a furlong out and in turn bumped that foe jostling a bit for space before weakening in the very late stages to the wire. GALLERY chased the pace five then four wide under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, spun four wide for home moving into contention in upper stretch, was under an offside stick and leaned on the aforementioned foe briefly a furlong out before he and that rival traded some minor bumps, then weakened in the late stages to the line. ZANDAR just off the inside in pursuit from near the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no late headway. BOTTLE ROCKET bumped at the start lightly by READY FOR RYE, chased just off the inside from near the rear under urging from three furlongs out, spun three wide for home and offered no response. ELEMENT chased the pace three to four wide under urging from the three-eighths, angled five to six wide for home, offered no response. BEANTOWN SAINT broke in at the start bumping lightly with DISCO PARTNER, vied inside a pair lightly coaxed before tucking to the rail midway on the turn put to further encouragement, cut the corner into upper stretch and came under threat from a host, got headed straightened away and tired.
