Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes allowed, 2lbs, a sweepstakes at a mile or over allowed, 4 lbs, a race at a mile or over since November 19th allowed, 6 lbs. (Maid en and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters. KATHMANBLU raced three wide on the first turn, was rank when given cover early on the backstretch then was reserved, went two then three wide early on the far turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, was roused in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead then edged clear under good handling. INGLORIOUS broke two lengths slow, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved near the back, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and finished well to garner the place. GRAN LIONESS was well rated while setting the pace, came under strong urging in upper stretch, led into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to hold the show. BOUQUET BOOTH was rated while off the rail and a bit rank on the first turn, continued a bit rank early on the backstretch, tracked the leader on the outside, went two to three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed kick. CHLOE KATE settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. TAPIT DANCER veered out at the start and was off a bit slow, was reserved near the back of the field, came under strong urging in upper stretch and failed to rally.
