RACHEL'S VALENTINA made light contact with NICKNAME being released from the starting gate, had the pilot go to work right afterwards

by applying some hand encouragment, moved outward in tandem with the previously-named opponent and got out-raced to position by that opponent, wound up in the four path at the five-sixteenths marker, picked up speed when asked, challenging in earnest as the widest of four front runners spinning into the stretch, got engaged in a spirtied tussle with the runner up that lasted until the final seventy yards, grabbed away the advantage midway through it and kicked away. AWESOME DAME broke on top and maintained the lead, showed the way from the two path before cutting over to the rail in the vicinity of the half mile pole, felt pressure from two other rivals parked to her outside all during the run around the bned, although not always the same two, spun into the stretch with the eventual winner, among others, in hot pursuit, vied with vigor to fend off the top one, relinquished with under a furlong to go, continued onward to be second best. BIG WORLD saved ground, was let out before the half had

been completed, proved no match. NICKNAME brushed with the winner after losing her footing at the break, settled into the two path, was let out a

notch and angled into the three path, ahead of RACHEL'S VALENTINE, approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was set down bidding for command as the field made its way into the lane, wasn't up to the task at hand and backed away. TALE FOR RUBY sat forwardly placed departing the backstretch from the three path, stalked a pair of foes for the next furlong, remained prominently placed, although a bid closer to the rail than

before, for an additional furlong before giving way. WICKED FUN guided onto the inside route coming to the end of the backstretch, failed to menace. TRANSACT two wide, prompted the pace to the three-eighths pole between foes for a good portion of the way to it, was rank fighting the
