By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse to be divided as follows: \$87,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth and the remaining \$3,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade/Group One race at a mile or over in 2015-16 allowed 2 lbs., a Grade/Group Two race at a mile or over in 2015-16 allowed 4 lbs.; a Grade/Group Three race at a mile or over in 2015-16 allowed 6 lbs.; a race other than maiden claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2016 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 75)

THEOGONY bobbled slightly at the break and recovered to attend the leader in closest aim from the two path through the opening bend before shifting to the three path down the backstretch, remained patiently handled tracking until nearing the quarter pole when given her cue, took over command swinging just off the inside for home, went clear under a drive kept to task to the finish. MEI LING tracked the pace three wide from afar among a trio in the second albeit miniscule flight, came under coaxing in tandem with JOINT RETURN seven-sixteenths out, swung three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one through the stretch while keeping on to be along clear for the place honors. SWEETGRASS inside through the first turn, settled three wide at the rear, tipped to the inside five furlongs from home, came under coaxing down inside a pair midway on the far turn, spun just off the inside for home, kept on for the show honors while never threatening the winner. JOINT RETURN tracked the pace just off the inside early on before taking to the four path into the backstretch, raced four wide from that point forward among a trio, came under coaxing in unison with MEI LING seven-sixteenths from home, advanced in tandem with those rivals into striking range nearing the quarter pole, continued four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. MILAYA broke out a step at the start and was corrected, established the front and showed the way along the inside in hand uncontested before taking to the two path down the backstretch, remained patiently handled until put to urging with five-sixteenths to go, came under pressure for the initial time nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner headed for the front into upper stretch, weakened in the final eighth.
