1 1/4 MILES. (1.473) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *RAMPART S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$150 each by Saturday, March 14, 2009, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000; \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made on Thursday, March 26, 2009, at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade/group I or II sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes 4 lbs., of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2009 6 lbs., of one race other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2009 8 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. High Weights Preferred with second preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Trophy to winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, March 14th, 2009 with 11 nominations. (Showery 82)

ONE CAROLINE sprinted to a clear lead while drifting out entering the first turn, was eased in to make the pace three wide, then increased her margin through the stretch while in hand. SEA CHANTER stalked the winner three wide to nearing the stretch, then was no match for that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. GINGER BREW unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to reach contention on the far turn, then tired. STRIKING TOMISUE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and faltered. HAMSA stalked the pace into the far turn and faded. AFRICAN VIOLET was outrun. SO GLITZY was through after six furlongs.
