BEHAVING BADLY sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, angled in on a clear lead on the turn and proved best under a couple cracks of the whip and good handling. TRUE AND TRUE stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn, continued off the rail in the stretch and held second. ALLSWELLTHATNSWELL chased outside then off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and gained the show. SOMETHINABOUTLAURA stalked between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. PROPOSED saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside on the turn and also weakened. SHORT ROUTE bobbed at the start, stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and had little left.
