6 $\frac{1}{2}$ FURLONGS. (1.15²) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *RANCHO BERNARDO H. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD*. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. The Rancho Bernardo Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The winner of the Rancho Bernardo Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2008 running of the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint, subject to the payment of all pre-entry, entry and supplementary (if applicable) fees. To be eligible for the 2008 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita on October 24-25, 2008, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (local time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 14, 2008. All applicable fees shall accompany the pre-entry. Weights Monday, August 18. High weights preferred. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 14, 2008, with 24. (Cloudy 76)

DEAREST TRICKSKI sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, inched away in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. TIZ ELEMENTAL stalked between horses, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. LA TEE close up tracking the winner inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held third. SILKY SMOOTH chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. MAGNIFICIENCE a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail, went outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. SOCIETY HOSTESS settled outside then off the rail, angled in for the turn and lacked the needed rally. SPRING AWAKENING close up stalking the winner outside a rival then off the rail to the stretch, weakened. HIGHLAND TORREE in a good position stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn, angled in a bit into the stretch and also weakened. MAKOR'S LOVE had her head turned, dwelt in the gate and was away far behind the field, was always outrun and was eased in the stretch.
