**7 FURLONGS. (1.223) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 LEXUS RAVEN RUN S.(GRADE II) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$186,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$9,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2006, 4 lbs.; a Grade III or \$60,000 once in 2006, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lexus Raven Run will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2006. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 11, 2006 with 39 nominations. (Clear 55)**

**Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Maj), by Tiger Ridge - Lady Cruella by Capote. Trainer Pitts Helen. Bred by Hartley/DeRenzo Thoroughbreds(FL).**

**LEAH'S SECRET** stalked the pace from early on while four or five wide, took over leaving the eighth pole and was hard ridden the remainder. **VESTREY LADY**, up close between foes from early on, reached the front in the upper stretch, was headed by the winner at the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. **EX CAELIS**, outsprinted early and between foes much of the way, moved seven wide into the lane, angled between horses four wide in the final furlong and finished willingly. **WINDY** settled in behind horses early, lacked room behind a wall of horses entering the upper stretch, worked her way out six wide but could gain only slightly at the end. **STARRY PIE**, outrun for a half and four wide, swung out nine wide for the stretch run and improved position. **MY LUCKY FREE**, in contention while near the inside between foes into the upper stretch, angled near the inside but came up empty. **CHANDELLE NO. FIVE**, within easy striking distance while between rivals four or five wide, faltered when the test came. **MORNER**, in front after the start, was eased back to track the pace five wide, continued forwardly into the upper stretch, fanned wider and flattened out. **CHEROKEE JEWEL** raced prominently two wide into the upper stretch and was empty. **SABATINI** settled near the inside early, saved ground most of the way, eased out three wide in the late going and never menaced. **JAZZY OKIE**, six or seven wide to the stretch, was nine wide when straightened for the drive and tired. **LAKE ALICE** moved to the front early, showed the way three or four wide, briefly was clear on the turn, made the pace into the upper stretch and faltered.
