7 FURLONGS. (1.204) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 LEXUS RAVEN RUN S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$12,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II or \$58,800 twice in 2013, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lexus Raven Run will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2013. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, Octob er 2, 2013 with 39 nominations. Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Cactus Ridge - An Annika Moment by Mecke. Trainer Eurlton Peter. Bred by La Ciega, LLC(KY).

MADAME CACTUS settled in hand, circled nine wide leaving the turn, reeled in the leader and was up in the final yards. **EDEN PRAIRIE** tracked the pace three wide, forged command entering the stretch, shook clear and kept on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. **MY OPTION** settled between horses, took closer order through the turn, came five wide and was making up ground. **CIAO BELLA LUNA** settled in hand, moved up five wide to make her bid, drifted in through the drive and flattened. **IRISH LUTE** was unhurried into stride, six wide, looped up through the turn and improved position. **FULLY LIVING** was close up five wide, but weakened between rivals in the drive and faded. **PRIMED FOR PASSION** was unhurried into stride, closed the gap between foes, was caught in tight when **CIAO BELLA LUNA** came in, steadied and failed to threaten thereafter. **ELUSIVE FATE** contended between horses in mid pack and went evenly. **SILSITA** settled between rivals, came five wide, found room entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. **SITTIN AT THE BAR** was unhurried along the inside, finished with a belated gain between foes but was never a factor. **JEWEL OF A CAT** contended along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. **TURN BY TURN** opened clear to set the pace, was headed entering the stretch and gave way readily. **FINDING MORE** was close up between horses through the turn and retreated. **THETALOVEANDMINE** saved ground to no avail.
