7 FURLONGS. (1:21) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Lexus Raven Run S.FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2016 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2016 or \$60,000 twice in 2016, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lexus Raven Run will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2016. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 5, 2016 with 34 nominations. (Clear 51)

LIGHTSTREAM was unhurried early along the six path, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, drove past the leaders four wide and cleared the field in the final stages. MALIBU STACY bobbed at the start but was well placed early from the four path, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a strong bid three wide down the lane but did not have enough late. CONIAH broke in at the start, vied for the lead early along the five path, stayed in the five path entering the lane, took over and led in the stretch from between horses but hung in the late stages. CURLIN'S APPROVAL pressed the pace early from between horses, shifted into the three path entering the lane but flattened out late in the stretch run. GRACE'S TREASURE chased the pace early from the three path, stayed along the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. SOUTHERN GIRL broke out and was bumped at the start, trailed the field early on, fanned into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. TAKREES was back early along the five path, fanned into the seven path in the turn with some gain while widest down the lane. COVEY TRACE stalked the pace early from the inside, shifted into the three path in the turn and faded down the lane. SOPHIA'S SONG was through after a half. BELLAMENTARY was bumped and bothered at the start, shied from rival early on, shifted into the three path in the turn and was empty late. MA CAN DO IT was done early. LUCY N ETHEL set the pace for a half then folded up.
