(GRADE II) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$200 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$10,000 which qualifies to start with \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over anytime 5 lbs.; \$18,000 at any distance 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 6, 2009 at \$300 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Nominations for The Rebel closed Friday, March 5, 2010 with 96 nominees. (Cloudy 49)

LOOKIN AT LUCKY bothered start, settled off the pace and the inside, jumped across NOBLE'S PROMISE heels when that one came out just outside the half mile marker, quickly recovered, advanced four wide into contention turning for home, set down, late bid, gained the nod in a game effort. NOBLE'S PROMISE never far back in the second flight, remained within striking distance in hand, came out with just over a half mile remaining to tighten up the winner, ranged up outside to challenge soon after in the three path, shook clear past the furlong grounds, could not contain the winner. DUBLIN five wide into the first turn, made an early move to join the first flight four wide into the far turn, vied into the lane on equal terms with the runner up, weakened the final furlong. UH OH BANGO jostled at the start, recovered to prompt the pace, vied between foes in the second turn, also faltered in the drive. CARDIFF GIANT broke out, settled in the second flight along the inside, lacked a response in the drive. PLEASANT STORM jostled at the start, fell back to trail, never involved. ROYAL EXPRESS bothered at the start, recovered to set the pace, got clear in the run up the backstretch, gave way in the drive.
