(GRADE II) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$300 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$3,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$10,000 which qualifies to start with \$500,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among all other starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over anytime 5 lbs.; \$18,000 at any distance 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 10, 2012 at \$500 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Nominations closed Friday, March 9, 2012 with 93 nominees. (Cloudy 75)

SECRET CIRCLE forwardly placed early off the inside, four wide late backstretch when falling off the issue a bit, advanced from between foes in the second turn, set down for the drive, took over with a sixteenth to run, clear late, enough left to hold the runner up safe in the waning strides. OPTIMIZER lacked speed, two path into the far turn, asked three furlongs out, angled out and came six wide into the stretch, set down for the drive in upper stretch, was rallying when angled inside the winner and finished full of run to be getting to that rival late. SCATMAN broke in, chased early, moved up to join the early leader onto the backstretch, alternated up front, disposed of the other speed late in the second turn, clear into the lane, could not contain the top two, lasted for the show. JAKE MO settled off the pace toward the inside, began a modest advance in the second turn, improved into the lane, evenly under the wire. CYBER SECRET forwardly placed while being firmly rated toward the front, three wide into the far turn when moving a bit closer, had little more for the drive. NAJJAAR off a bit slow, trailed, continued to race well back for six furlongs, swung out to be widest in the drive, staged a belated run down the middle of the strip to improve position. ADIRONDACK KING five wide into the first turn to lose some ground, mid pack in the run up the backstretch, advanced five wide far turn, came six wide into the stretch, flattened out bit. SABERCAT lacked speed, two path while continuing near the back, lacked a significant late response when asked in the drive. PEE H DEE lacked speed, was never involved while also racing mostly in the two path. RECKLESS JERRY raced in midpack and off the inside, failed to muster a rally. ATIGUN away in good order, moved a bit closer while four wide late in the second turn, gave way. UNBRIDLED'S NOTE in a bit tight at the start, clear early, dueled up the backstretch, stopped in the second turn, finished far back.
