1 1/8 MILE. (1:40¹) STAKES. Purse \$900,000 Rebel S.THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$4,500 to pass the entry box and \$4,500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$12,500 which qualifies to start with \$900,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among all other starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2016 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over anytime allowed 5 lbs.; \$35,000 at any distance allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 5, 2016 at \$750 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2016 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Closed Friday, March 11, 2016 with 77 nominees. (Clear 54)

Gray or Roan Colt, (May), by Tapit - Pretty 'n Smart by Beau Genius. Trainer Bob Baffert. Bred by JKG Thoroughbreds LLC (KY).

CUPID broke behind the leaders, used to secure inside position up front into the first turn, pace, given a breather into the far turn when maintaining daylight advantage, continued to hold a daylight edge past the furlong marker, responded when the runner up challenged late, kicked clear again in the waning strides in finding more. WHITMORE lacked speed, was firmly rated in the run up the backstretch, moved inside a bit into the far turn, accelerated when asked in the second turn, five wide midway on that bend, angled in steadily midstretch, challenged outside the winner with a sixteenth remaining, could not match strides with that one late, remained clear for the place. CREATOR last away, moved out in the run up the backstretch, four wide into the far turn, shifted out to be five wide soon after, lost considerable ground to the winner into the lane, finished willingly to earn the show. CHERRY WINE near the back off the inside three wide in the far turn when beginning to rally, traffic, split foes in the three path into the lane, improved position with some modest late interest. SUDDENBREAKINGNEWS raced well back early, in some traffic while still back far turn, briefly lost action inside of a rival, steadied, moved out for the drive then mounted a mild rally down the middle of the strip. GRAY SKY in mid pack while outside, four wide in the second turn, moved closer into the lane, flattened out the final furlong. DISCREETNESS void of speed, saved some ground into the far turn in the two path, improved inside of several foes into the lane, lacked a further bid. CUTACORNER raced in mid pack outside, slightly closer on the outside in the second turn, had little left for the drive. SPIKES SHIRL forwardly placed for six furlongs off the inside, began to falter when the real running began at the head of the lane. RALIS broke sharply, saved ground to no avail. Z ROYAL outrun in the early going, moved in a bit with a half mile remaining, backed up in the drive. MADTAP forwardly placed for a half, gave way while in the three path. AMERICAN DUBAI settled toward the front, stopped after five furlongs. SIDING SPRING away in good order, pressured the winner on the outside for five furlongs and also stopped.
