1 MILE. (Turf) (1.32) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *RED BANK S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 to start. The owner of the winner to receive \$120,000, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$5,000 to fifth and \$2,500 to sixth through last. Three-Year-Olds: 118 lbs.; Older: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since November 1, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 on the turf, 5 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf since June 1, 2010, 7 lbs. The winning owner to receive a trophy. Closed Sunday, August 22, 2010 with 17 nominations. A \$5,000 supplemental nomination, which included all fees, was made at time of entry, Thursday, September 2, 2010. Monmouth Park and the Graded Stakes Committee require steroid testing on all Graded Stakes races. (Clear 76)

GET SERIOUS stumbled and was bumped at the start, then was bounced around and crowded soon after, tracked AT THE DISCO, commenced his bid midway on the far turn, moved up alongside that rival in upper stretch, put a head in front, kicked away and held on determinedly late under urging. NOWNOWNOW was content to trail, saved ground while moving up on the turn, cut the corner nicely, angled off the rail in upper stretch, closed gamely outside but came up a bit short. BOOTS AHEAD settled off the rail, chased the leaders on the far turn and rallied mildly for the show. AT THE DISCO bumped with GET SERIOUS at the break, set the pace, dug in gamely when challenged and weakened in the final furlong. STRIKE AGAIN was bumped after the break, raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. LEGAL MOVE stalked early, then raced between rivals and failed to threaten.
