7 FURLONGS. (1.231) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *RED LEGEND S. THREE YEARS OLD.* Free nominations. Nominations close Saturday, June 4, 2011. \$1500 to pass the entry box, with \$400,000 guaranteed. Supplemental nominations of \$20,000 will be accepted by closing of entries, all fees included and non-refundable for supplements. Entries close Wednesday June 15, 2011 by usual time of closing. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to 6th. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2011 allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of \$22,000 since April 1, 2011 allowed 6 lbs., a race other than maiden or claiming in 2011, allowed 9 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four on the alternates list. Preference to North American, European, and Asian graded or group stakes winners in order (Grade 1, then Grade 2, then Grade 3), then to highest earnings in North American, European and Asian graded and group stakes, then to highest lifetime stakes earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Cloudy 86)

J P'S GUSTO prompted the pace outside DER MEISTER, overtook that one approaching the three eighths pole, opened up under urging on the far turn and was kept under brisk rousing through the stretch. LORANGER NATIVE, forwardly placed along the rail, angled to three path for room midway on the far turn, was taken back to the rail in upper stretch and rallied gamely. NACHO SAINT, a forward factor two wide on the first turn, circled the far turn three wide and finished willingly. LITTLE DRAMA, fractious in the starting gate, raced three wide on the first turn, chased the pace to the stretch then weakened. YANKEE PASSION, wide both turns, was not a factor. DECISIVE MOMENT, two wide the first turn, was four wide on the far turn and failed to be a factor. VEE'S ACCOLADE, wide the far turn, was outrun. B G SUAVECITO stumbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground and faded in the drive. BLACK N BEAUTY, three wide the first turn, was outrun. DER MEISTER had speed along the rail, gave way near the quarter pole and faltered in the stretch.
