1¹/₂ MILES. (Turf) (2.14¹) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 **RED SMITH H. (GRADE III) A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$5,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,250 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, November 2, 2013 with 44 nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Quarter on the Inner Dirt.). (Clear 58)

Chestnut Horse, (Jan), by Giant's Causeway - Daydreaming by A.P. Indy. Trainer McGaughey III R. Claude. Bred by Phipps Stable(KY).

IMAGINING strung out three wide on each and every turn, challenged in earnest coming to the quarter pole, wrestled away the lead with about an eighth to go, then dug in with determination to preserve the decision. HANGOVER KID made light contact with HOWE GREAT at the start, was unhurried from off the inside, commenced the stretch six wide and charged down the outside of the course of the course to garner the place. TANNERY (IRE) fanned into the nine path travelling through the furlong grounds, displayed strong late foot en route for the show. SLIP AND DRIVE loosely pocketed, lacked the needed response. SKY BLAZER on the track well before the post parade was sent out, galloped off strongly going the wrong way, took the three path around the middle turn and remained at a considerable distance from off the rail thereafter, swung four wide into the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. ARTIC NORTH along the inside, had no rally. HOWE GREAT brushed with HANGOVER KID leaving the gate, got sharply angled into the five path coming to the three-sixteenths pole, made no impact. HYPER three wide on the first turn, tired. MISSION APPROVED broke sharply and was quickly sent over to the rail, rated kindly cutting the pace to the quarter pole, got overtaken nearing the end of the furlong grounds and steadily backed away. EXCLUSIVE STRIKE was never in contention. SANDYINTHESUN folded. NUTELLO prompted the pacesetter from the two path then retreated.
