VILLAGE KING (ARG) coaxed from the gate, raced just off the inside just off the pace through the opening bend before taking to the six path down the backstretch, tucked to the two path once more at the half mile pole for the journey around the far turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung four wide into upper stretch in behind EXULTING with SOGLIO to his outside, angled in nearing the eighth pole to arily up inside a trio a furlong from home taking command just inside the eighth pole, inched away briefly before coming under threat from a runner up, dug in and gamely prevailed on the wire by a nostril. SOGLIO stumbled at the start bumping with GALOPE AMERICANO when recovering inwards, raced three wide through the first turn before settling just off the pace seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied through the final furlong to latch on the aforementioned foe a sixteenth from home, ding donged to the finish and just missed on the wire. CONTROL GROUP coaxed from the gate, raced inside forwardly placed through the first turn before taking to the four path down the backstretch under rating and latched on the leader to the inside, tucked inside half a mile from home advancing to issue a challenge for the initial time, knocked heads through the far turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, traded leans with EXULTING straightened away, dug in under threat from a trio and was headed inside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages while holding for the show honors. EXULTING off half a beat slow when rocking to the back of the stall as the gate was sprung, came under coaxing and established the front to show the way in hand just off the inside through the first turn before settling under rating five paths off the inside down the backstretch under little pressure save the presence of CONTROL GROUP latched on the inside, remained patiently handled coming under growing pressure from that rival to eventually knock heads through the far turn placed to coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch, traded leans with CONTROL GROUP headed for command, dug in and weakened in the late going. RED KNIGHT broke awkwardly lunging at the start, raced three to four wide through the first turn before settling four to five wide in pursuit down the backstretch near the rear of the field, came under coaxing three wide at the three-eighths, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, kept on the same pace through to the finish but was outkicked. GALOPE AMERICANO (BRZ) bumped at the start by SOGLIO who recovered inwards from a stumble, raced two to three wide through the opening bend, remained unhurried five paths off the inside down the backstretch growing detached at the tail of the field, came under light coaxing half a mile from home while four to five wide, swung six to seven wide at the head of the stretch and trailed.
