SWEET FERVOR moved up three wide into the turn, chased and was no match while second best. CHEROKEE JEWEL broke through the gate, eased out for a clear path in upper stretch and gained late for the show award. LIVERMORE VALLEY pressed the early issue, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. SUMMER STING never far back, raced near the inside into the turn and lacked the needed rally. CRAFTY JUDY a bit fractious briefly in the gate, raced outside on the turn, was four wide into the lane and tired. PURE DISCO stumbled badly at the start unseating the rider. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the start prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
