1½ MILES. (Turf) (1.461) STAKES. Purse \$125,000 REGRET S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$125 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$625 to pass the entry box; \$625 additional to start, with \$125,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over a mile allowed 2 lbs.; a graded sweepstakes over a mile on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 29, 2010 with 37 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.) . (Cloudy 88)

Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by More Than Ready - Stoneway by Storm Boot. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Stoneway Farm(KY).

CAMINADORA outrun for a half, made a run five wide on the second turn, took over inside the final furlong and held sway late. **SNOW TOP MOUNTAIN** outrun early, made a good three wide middle move, angled out for a clear path in midstretch and closed well. **QUEEN HAZEL** unhurried four wide, angled out and made a good five wide run on the second turn, challenged with a furlong to go, drifted in tightening up **JODY SLEW** in midstretch then held on gamely. **IT'S TEA TIME** within striking distance off the inside, advanced in that position after a half, challenged in midstretch, drifted out a bit soon after then held on gamely. **DYNAZAPER** forwardly placed four wide, moved in a path on the backstretch, reeled in the early leader, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but weakened. **BEAUTICIAN** unhurried three wide, angled in a bit approaching the stretch then lacked the needed closing bid. **LA GRAN BAILADORA** reserved near the inside, made a late gain. **JODY SLEW** forwardly placed four wide, moved closer in the four path on the second turn, steadied in midstretch when challenging then tired. **JOHARMONY** could not menace along the inside. **AMBITONESS** within striking distance, moved four wide late on the second turn and was no threat. **GO ASK ALEX** set the pace, drew off before a half, led the field for six furlongs and gave way. **QUEEN OF THE CREEK** rank early when close up, dropped back before a half, reeled in the leader into the second turn but was through soon after six furlongs.
