A supplemental nomination fee of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any point prior to the closing time of entries. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at a mile or over other than restricted allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 12, 2011 with 25 Nominations. (Clear 62)

O'PRADO AGAIN came in and made contact with MANAGED ACCOUNT just out of the starting gate, raced three wide around both turns, steadily advanced into contention down the backstretch, remained on hold until the quarter pole, responded positively when given his cue, took over leaving the furlong grounds and edged away. SOUPER SPEEDY was rated along the inside while setting the splits, raced on nearly even terms with OUR ENTOURAGE parked in the two path just off his hind quarters, felt increased pressure from the previously mentioned rival midpoint on the second turn, shook off that rival's challenge coming to the eighth pole, dug in well before relinquishing to the winner, then just reached the wire just in time to salvage second. EL PADRINO between rivals, came home with good, but belated foot, en route for the show. DONE TALKING rode the rail, was eased off the inside at three-eighths pole, lacked the needed late response. OUR ENTOURAGE assumed a forward post after the start, sat under a firm hold attending the pacesetter from the two path, ranged up to increase the pressure nearing the three-eighths pole, raced on nearly terms with SOUPER SPEEDY for the rest of the way towards the quarter pole, with the rider sitting chilly aboard, was let out as the front runners battled down the lane, fell back slightly approaching the eighth pole and tired. MANAGED ACCOUNT bumped with the winner after stumbling at the start, had no rally. STEPHANOATSEE fanned five wide into upper stretch, had no offering to tender. SPEIGHTSCITY well off the inside throughout, was under a drive from the four path into the stretch, made no impact. MUCHO MAS MACHO placed four wide and set down at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. SCATTER A STAR saved ground and faltered.
