(GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$300 by Saturday, February 11th (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$1,250 to enter; \$1,450 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$6,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes allowed, 2lbs, a sweepstakes at a mile or over, allowed, 4lbs, \$27,000 twice at a mile or over, allowed, 6lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses according to highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed SSaturday, February 11, 2012, with 79 nominations. (Cloudy 55)

Chestnut Colt, (Jan), by Pulpit - Enchanted Rock by Giant's Causeway. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Emory A. Hamilton(KY).

EL PADRINO came out entering the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled nicely while just off the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, brushed with MARK VALESKI while making a bid passing the eighth-pole, dueled with that rival in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. MARK VALESKI stalked the leader on the outside, drew even midway through the far turn, put a head in front at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive, brushed with EL PADRINO passing the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with that rival in the final furlong and was denied. Z DAGER was well placed just off the pace, came under urging on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and earned the show while no match for the top two. HERO OF ORDER was hustled to the lead, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired then was caught for the show. SHARED PROPERTY went four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. AFFORD broke out and bumped with a rival, was rank while under a strong hold through the first turn then reserved off the pace, came under urging while inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and came up empty. TIZANEXPENSE was forced six wide early on the turn then dropped to five wide, moved to four wide by late on that turn, was reserved while eager and into the bit, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. TED'S FOLLY lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and failed to threaten. OPTIMIZER bumped with a rival at the start then was taken up, raced three wide while eager early on the first turn, shifted five wide midway through that turn, was reserved on the outside, went four then five wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, drifted out in the final furlong and was no factor. ADENA'S CHANCE raced three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was roused on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and never reached contention. MR. BOWLING settled while off the rail, was roused on the far turn and also failed to respond.
