1 1/4 MILES. (1.42) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 RISEN STAR S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, February 9 (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$8,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes allowed, 2lbs, a sweepstakes at a mile or over, allowed, 4lbs, \$27,000 twice at a mile or over, allowed, 6lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Risen Star Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 9, 2013, with 90 nominations. (Cloudy 60)

IVE STRUCK A NERVE was carried four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, lagged near the back while unhurried, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. CODE WEST pressed the pace on the outside, took a short lead midway down the backstretch, lost the advantage to OXBOW passing the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back a bit under a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, battled back gamely to make a bid passing the sixteenth-pole and just missed. PALACE MALICE went three wide on the first turn, settled amongst horses while under some restraint, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied under a drive, chased into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole but missed while just able to get the show. OXBOW was caught five wide on the first turn, raced up close while on the outside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, gained a short lead near the five-sixteenths pole, led into the final furlong but was overtaken late and missed the show. NORMANDY INVASION broke a bit slow then bobbled, angled in at the rear, lugged out while rank into the first turn, drifted five wide midway through that bend, was reserved well back while on the outside, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to six wide outside the quarter-pole, came seven wide into the stretch, gained ground on the outside and finished well but was too late. GOLDEN SOUL raced near the inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. MYLUTE was rated under a very strong hold, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong and weakened. PROUD STRIKE was asked from the start, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead midway down the backstretch, dropped back with three furlongs to run, saved ground into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. BETHEL raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside and showed little. AGENT went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace while between horses, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired. CIRCLE UNBROKEN went four wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, dropped back while four wide on the far turn, drifted in in upper stretch and retreated. HARDROCK ELEVEN went four then five wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, raced five wide early on the far turn, dropped back then moved closer to the inside and faltered.
