Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Tale of Ekati - Catch the Moon by Malibu Moon. Trainer Joe Sharp. Bred by Bob Austin & John Witte (KY). GIRVIN brushed the inside of the gate at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked at the half-mile pole, rounded the far turn in the two path, was roused inside the three-eighths, rallied under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, made a bid while switched to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, swapped leads back and forth while moving clear coming to the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. UNTRAPPED raced in the two path on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn, angled to the four path at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. LOCAL HERO was hustled to the lead, raced in the three then two path on the first turn, opened up a sizable advantage, came under some urging in the two path on the far turn, was asked for more at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage at the furlong marker and weakened while just able to hold the show. GUEST SUITE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, angled out near the three-sixteenths and improved position to just miss the show. MO TOWN went four then three wide on the first turn, settled behind the runaway leader, was ridden along in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and tired. SHAREHOLDER VALUE went two then three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SORRY ERIK went four wide on the first turn, was reserved outside then moved inside a rival midway down the backstretch, came under urging at the half-mile pole, was ridden along in the four path early on the far turn, moved to the six path near the five-sixteenths and failed to respond. ARKLOW saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. U S OFFICER went two to three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while inside on the far turn and was no factor. COOL ARROW went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide early on the far turn, moved to the five path while dropping back at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under the whip and capitulated then was not urged late. HORSE FLY went five then four wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, fell to the rear while four to five wide on the far turn and faltered then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
