6 FURLONGS. (1:07<sup>3</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Rockville Centre S. FOR TWO YEAR OLDS FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-Winners of a race other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens allowed 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 30, 2018 with 10 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Clear 86)

Chestnut Colt, (Mar), by Flatter - Jonata by Proud Citizen. Trainer Todd A. Pletcher. Bred by Stonewall Farm (NY).

LA FUERZA chased along the inside in range of the front, came under light coaxing half a mile from home, tipped out three wide at the five-sixteenths, advanced and continued three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take over command just outside the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive kept to task. BUSTIN MACH FOUR four then three wide in aim of the front, came under coaxing between rivals at the three-eighths in the three path stacked outside a pair, came in near the quarter pole forcing WHAT THE LUCK to check off his heels and got clipped behind, then put HUSHION in tight along the fence forcing that rival to briefly steady while seizing command, cut the corner straightened away for home, dug in and was headed just outside the eighth pole, ran on safe for the place honors. RED ZINGER bumped at the start by WHAT THE LUCK who broke inwards, raced just off the inside just off the pace, tipped out four wide nearing the three-eighths put to coaxing and advanced to stack outside a trio through the latter portion of the turn, swung three then two wide straightened away into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. HUSHION broke in under coaxing at the start, cut the pace along the inside coming under coaxing three furlongs out under pressure from a trio, hugged the fence nearing the quarter pole and was headed for command nearing that station before being put in tight and forced to briefly steady as BUSTIN MACH FOUR came inwards before cutting the corner directly in front straightened away for home, then tired through the stretch. WHAT THE LUCK broke in at the start bumping RED ZINGER before being corrected, chased three then two wide through the turn coming between foes three furlongs from home put to coaxing, had BUSTIN MACH FOUR drift in when seizing command nearing the quarter pole and was forced to check off that rivals heels when impeded, clipped heels with the back of that rival bobbling at that station, altered out four to five wide into upper stretch losing all chance and was not overly persevered with to the finish. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the incident at the top of the stretch as well as two Claims of foul, one by the rider of WHAT THE LUCK alleging interference against BUSTIN MACH FOUR at the quarter pole and the other by the rider of HUSHION alleging interference against RED ZINGER at the head of the stretch. After review, the result stood and the pair of objections were dismissed prior to the race being declared official.
