GOTTA HAVE HER bobbled slightly a step out of the gate and was squeezed a bit, settled inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. BURG BERG had speed outside a rival then angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, fought back from the fence through the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. U R ALL THAT I AM saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and gained the show late. ROSEY DE MEGEVE (GB) pulled a bit and stalked inside then just off the rail, bid alongside BURG BERG on the second turn and between horses in the stretch and was outfinished late for third. SPRING STYLE (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came out into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip past the furlong marker and lacked the needed late kick. EXQUISITE (NZ) chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside the winner on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in and could not offer the necessary response.
