POOL LAND came away well, hounded pacesetter TAKE D' TOUR from the outside for three quarters, responded when sent after that rival approaching the stretch, dug in resolutely under a steady drive and drew clear nearing the finish. TAKE D' TOUR quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, dug in when challenged by the winner and stayed on stubbornly through the stretch. MISS SHOP was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the turn and weakened outside in the final furlong. CLASSY CHARM dropped back early, was outrun along the inside into the stretch and had no response when roused. SUMMERLY raced in hand outside early on, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch.
