CAVORTING four wide in pursuit early on, tucked to the three path five furlongs out, came under coaxing midway on the turn advancing three wide through the latter portion to issue a challenge nearing the quarter pole, took command at that station and swung three to four wide into upper stretcj set down for the drive, drew clear under a drive and was ridden out to the finish. CARRUMBA three wide in closest range of the leader,

remained patiently handled until between foes nearing the quarter pole, swung just off the inside for home, proved no match for the top one through the final furlong while running on to be along clear for the place honors. SPELLING AGAIN broke in at the start bumping INCLUDE BETTY, tracked the pace along the inside, shifted off the rail three furlongs out placed to coaxing, gradually angled out through the latter portion of the turn to swing four wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the late going while along for the show. CALAMITY KATE broke open the gate prior to the start when fractious and was backed out and reloaded, broke well to establish the front and show the way just off the inside under attendance and some pressure to the outside, tucked to the inside midway on the turn, came under coaxing as CAVORTING ranged up three wide five-sixteenths from home, got headed nearing the quarter pole put to a drive, cut the corner into upper stretch and tired. INCLUDE BETTY bumped lightly at the start by SPELLING AGAIN who broke inwards, raced five wide early on until tucked to the three path with five furlongs to go, came under a ride three furlongs from home, angled five wide at the top of the stretch and offered no response. WELCOME ABOARD five wide in the early going, tucked to the three path with five and a half furlongs remaining, came under prolonged coaxing seven-sixteentsh from home chasing just off the inside, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and trailed.
