LADY MARLBORO chased the pace along the rail, slipped through inside MINI SERMON in the stretch, responded when headed by GOLDEN VELVET at the eighth pole and came back on in the final strides to finish on even terms with that rival. GOLDEN VELVET stalked the pace, was steadied midway of the turn to avoid running up on MINI SERMON, angled to the outside and rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then was all out to just last for a dead heat with LADY MARLBORO. MINI SERMON showed speed between horses to nearing the eighth pole, then weakened. SILVER KNOCKERS pressed the pace three wide to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. POTRA CLASICA (ARG) was outrun.
