GREG'S GOLD dueled between horses then outside a rival, put a head in front into the stretch, inched away in deep stretch and was caught nearing the wire. SOUL CITY SLEW stalked the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and bested the others. JOHNNY EVES had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened late. CIRCULAR QUAY squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. MEN ONLY bobbed at the start, dropped back inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch then chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. COOPERATION dueled three deep then stalked outside a rival into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
