Purse \$300,000 *SAN DIEGO H.(GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$300 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. The San Diego Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The winner of the San Diego Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2008 running of the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, subject to the payment of all pre-entry, entry and supplementary (if applicable) fees. To be eligible for the 2008 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita Park on October 24-25, 2008, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (local time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 14, 2008. All applicable fees shall accompany the pre-entry. Weights Monday, July 14. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, July 10 2008, with 15. Y BOX WEDNESDAY, JULY 16, BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 75)

WELL ARMED sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, shook off the bid of GLOBAL HUNTER on the second turn, kicked clear under urging, came a bit off the rail in deep stretch and held sway. SURF CAT stalked the pace inside, came out past midstretch and finished well to be second best. MOSTACOLLI MORT slow into stride, settled inside then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and picked up the show. MR NAPPER TANDY (GB) also slowly into stride, angled in a bit off the rail, moved up leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was crowded off heels in deep stretch and could not offer the necessary response. REBELLION (GB) angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GLOBAL HUNTER (ARG) close up stalking the winner off the rail, bid alongside that one on the second turn, weakened in the stretch and drifted out a bit in deep stretch. TALL TEXAN pulled his way between horses then stalked outside a rival to the stretch, was crowded off heels in deep stretch and weakened. YOU GOT ME ROCKING three deep on the first turn, stalked off the rail, went between horses on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and also weakened. MAGNUM (ARG) chased a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. RACKETEER chased three wide then outside on the backstretch, continued three deep on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
