OILISBLACKGOLD angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. DON TITO had speed outside the runner-up then stalked just off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out approaching the stretch,

had the rider lose the whip when between foes just past the eighth pole and lacked the needed late kick. AGGIE ENGINEER chased three deep then alongside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. GOLDEN ITIZ stalked the pace outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and weakened. UH OH BANGO pulled early, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, dropped back and was eased late.
