By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf or two Grade 2 races on the turf since May 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 on the turf, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. BALL DANCING off half a beat slow, settled two to three wide near the rear, commenced a three to four wide bid three furlongs out to advance under coaxing into striking range swinging five wide into upper stretch, was let out fully at the head of the stretch, rallied into prominence a furlong out, battled head to head gamely with XCELLENCE taking command a sixteenth from home and held sway kept to task. XCELLENCE (FR) saved ground towards the rear, shifted out placed to urging for the initial time at the five-sixteenths to swing six wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, offered up a good kick to collar SEA QUEEN just inside the eighth pole in tandem with the aforementioned foe and hooked up head to head with that foe at that juncture, dug in gamely through to the wire getting headed a sixteenth out, fought on to the finish for the place. SEA QUEEN rated just off the inside on the pace through comfortable fractions, got let out at the head of the stretch spinning just off the inside for home, dug in under challenge from a pair and was displaced by the tandem just inside the eighth pole, stayed on readily through to the wire for the show honors. WALK CLOSE saved ground in mid pack, got let out at the quarter pole just off the inside, rallied splitting foes a furlong from home, offered up a mild kick to belatedly garner the last major share. A LITTLE BIT SASSY broke out at the start bumping QUEENOFZEENILE, settled under rating just off the pace two to three wide, came under encouragement nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station, kept on to the furlong grounds before weakening in the late stages. DARING DANCER broke in at the start bumping QUEENOFZEENILE, settled two to three wide in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. DUFF ONE three wide through the first turn, settled two to three wide in hand in range of the leader, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the lane. MISS BESILU tracked the pace along the inside in range of the leader, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner for home and weakened in the drive. QUEENOFZEENILE bumped between foes at the start each breaking her way, saved ground at the rear through to nearing the quarter pole when angled five to six wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
