By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One on the turf lifetime or two Grade Two races on the turf since May 1, 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two on the turf, 4 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 6 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by More Than Ready - Unaided (GB) by Dansili (GB). Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Haras D'Etreham (GB).
UNI (GB) settled just off the inside in mid pack under rating behind the cover of **FAULT**, had rivals advance outside and lost position unhurried inside into the far turn settling near the rear, came under light coaxing past the five-sixteenths, began to angle out to swing six wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick to issue a challenge through the final furlong latching on the leader a sixteenth from home and got up in the final jumps to prevail. **LA CORONEL** established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside a bit keen and fighting the rating of rider tepidly until into the backstretch, settled into a comfortable rhythm from that point onward under attendance from **EMPRESSOF THE NILE** to the outside but little pressure through sensible splits, remained patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner set down for the drive, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under lone threat and was caught in the final strides to the finish. **FAULT** just off the inside in aim of the leader under rating, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing with three furlongs remaining, cornered just off the inside for home and tipped out straightened away, offered up good energy to secure the show honors. **INFLEXIBILITY** three then two wide through the first turn, was steadied off heels with seven-eighths to go briefly into the backstretch and in turn forced **DEFIANT HONOR** to take hold in behind, raced three wide coming under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to procure the last major share. **FIFTY FIVE** just off the inside at the rear of the field, angled three wide nearing the three-eighths put to encouragement, swung eight wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. **VUE FANTASTIQUE (FR)** bounced around a bit in the gate anxious to get going, then missed the break getting away a beat slow after lunging slightly, settled just off the inside near the rear loosely behind the cover of **UNI**, came under coaxing half a mile from home having lost some ground to rivals in front, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and offered no response while improving position by a pair of tired foes. **EMPRESSOF THE NILE** three wide through the first turn, attended the leader three then two wide unhurried until put to a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, swung three wide at the quarter pole, tired in the stretch. **DEFIANT HONOR** raced three wide then two wide through the first turn and was forced to steady off the heels of **INFLEXIBILITY** as that rival steadied off the heels of **EMPRESSOF THE NILE** into the backstretch, raced three then four wide in the clear down the backstretch before tucking to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and tired.
