Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Fusaichi Pegasus - Squall Linda by Summer Squall. Trainer Cho Kwon Myung. Bred by Cho Myung Kwon(KY).

PREMIER PEGASUS floated out some into the first turn, stalked the pace outside or off the rail, moved up three deep on the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch to gain the lead and drew clear under left handed urging. JAYCITO bumped at the start, angled in and settled off the rail, advanced three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the place. BENCH POINTS angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, continued toward the fence in the drive and edged a rival for the show. COMMA TO THE TOP prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival early on the second turn, took the lead, inched away midway on that turn, kicked clear approaching the quarter pole, drifted out some into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and weakened but was edged for third. QUAIL HILL broke in and bumped the runner-up, angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. AWESOME PATRIOT drifted out a bit into the first turn, stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. SURREY STAR (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. JAKESAM angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and did not rally. ALBERGATTI had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn, came out some in the stretch, gave way and was eased. RUNFLATOUT dueled between horses then inside early on the second turn, stalked along the rail midway on that turn, also dropped back, gave way and was eased late.
