1 1/4 MILES. (1.39) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *SAN FELIPE S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS.* By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination. Closed Thursday, March 1st, 2012 with 3. \$4,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade III race at One Mile or Over, 5 lbs. *Early bird nominees to the 2012 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date Thursday, December 2, 2011) are automatically eligible to the San Felipe Stakes with all fees waived. Closed with 139. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 75)

Gray or Roan Colt, (Apr), by Giant's Causeway - Dream of Summer by Siberian Summer. Trainer Harrington Mike. Bred by James C. Weigel(KY).

CREATIVE CAUSE stalked outside then off the rail, moved up outside foes on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, drifted in then out some while bidding for the lead, gained the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging and strong handling. BODEMEISTER pulled early and pressed the pace outside a rival, took a short advantage on the second turn, fought back toward the inside in midstretch, drifted out from the whip a sixteenth from home and continued willingly to the wire. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, angled back to the inside past midstretch and bested the rest. LIAISON angled in and chased inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. ROUSING SERMON angled in and settled outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BLINGO saved ground early, split horses on the backstretch and again into the second turn, came out on that turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. AMERICAN ACT pulled his way along and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn, fell back some into the stretch and weakened. TIZ POINT also tugged while stalking the early pace outside a rival, but three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back leaving that turn, was in a bit tight into the stretch and gave way. EMPIRE WAY four wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. GROOVIN' SOLO saved ground stalking the pace, also fell back on the second turn and gave way.
