SCAT DADDY bumped at the start,settled just behind the pacesetter while saving ground, waited patiently along the rail leaving the turn, was taken to the outside in upper stretch then finished determinedly under strong left hand urging to get up in the final twenty yards. TEUFLESBERG rushed up to gain the early advantage, extended his lead on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead while moving back in under right hand urging in midstretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. WAR WOLF tucked in along the rail just off the early pace, swung wide leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. TRIP TO THE BANK bumped with the winner at the start, stalked the pace from outside for a half and steadily tired thereafter. BAGGER VANCE broke slowly with the rider briefly coming out of his right iron at the start then trailed throughout.
